Little Toddlers has school bags, summer caps and water bottles, ask the office for assistances to place orders and prices.

NOTE: If the registration fee is not paid within 3 days of notification you will forfeit your space. Should we have no space available immediately your details will be placed on a waiting list and you will be contacted as soon as space becomes available.

MEDICATION

The department of health stipulates, children who are ill are not permitted to attend school. We have a responsibility towards the other children and parents to ensure that ill children stay at home and do not affect the health of others, especially in the case of contagious illnesses.

Please complete the medication form in detail if your child requires medication during school hours, E.G Antibiotics. You will be notified immediately if your child becomes ill at school.

He/she will be removed from class and taken to the sickbay. If your child has a fever, we will contact the parent for permission to administer panado syrup according to the child's age. If you prefer us to administer a different pain reliver, make-sure its in the child's bag every-day. It's the parent responsibility to make sure the medication is not expired.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Mark your child's clothing, bottles, blankets ETC. The school will not be held responsible for the loss of any items. Children are not permitted to bring any toys to school as this course many tears with classmates. The item will be taken away and only sent back on a Friday.

Children should not wear new clothes to the school as their will be activities like painting and playing in the sandpit that will make them dirty.

LATE ARRIVAL PICKUP POLICY

If you not able to pickup your child by 18H00 alternate arrangements must be made.

Please notify the principal if any unauthorised person will be picking up your child. A late fee will be charged if the child remains in the care after 18H00.

POTTY TRAINING

We will work in conjunction with the parents during potty training. If you have a method that has been working for you, please let us know and we will adopt it for your child.

BIRTHDAYS

A birthday is a great event in a child's life. Parents are welcome to arrange with the principal before hand to bring refreshments on this day to celebrate your child's birthday.

Parents are welcome to send a cake or cupcakes, drinks, party packs and decorations to school. Parties are celebrated during 1st snack at 10am.

MEALS

Please send a healthy afternoon snack E.G yogurt, fruit or a sandwich.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Kids should wear they school T-shirt every Fridays or when communicated from the school. Kids must dress comfortable on Fridays as we do physical stimulation.

TUCK SHOP

We have a tuck shop every Fridays (allow kids to bring spending according to age, this is just to teach children independence with money and shopping. Always fill the amount you sending in the money form in the message book, as children do tend to play with the money and it gets missed placed.

- Butterfly's (18 months to 2 years)
- Smurf's (2 to 3 years)
- Dolphin's RRR (3 to 4 years)
- Bears RR (4 to 5 years)
- Lady-bug R (5 to 6 years)

Stationery

Specific items are required for each child (please mark all items with your child's name)

Stationery can be purchased from the office at request.

Note the stationery you buy from the school will be used for the entire year. If you purchasing the stationery on your own make sure you buy the requested quantity if not you will be sent with a stationery list during the course of the year.

All blankets should be clearly marked with your child's name. Blankets will be sent every Fridays for washing and should be returned on the Monday morning. If you forget to send the blanket, we do keep blankets at the school we will assist for the day.

BUSY BEE (3 MONTHS TO WALKING STAGE)

- Provide food or purity until your child can eat solids
- Enough pampers minimum 4 for half day and 6 for full day
- Bottom cream and wet-wipes
- Bottles with the correct amount water, pre-measured milk powder in a dispenser
- A4 hardcover book (communication book)
- Please note if your child does not come with pampers or wet -wipes the school will provide at a cost
- A thin receiving blanket for summer and a warm thick blanket for winter. (Right your child's name on the blanket)

BUTTERFLY (18 MONTHS TO 2 YEARS)
